



House rules at Camp Vught National Memorial

The following rules apply during your visit to Camp Vught National Memorial (hereinafter referred to as CVNM) and are aimed at ensuring a pleasant visit without disturbances for other visitors. These rules also apply to a visit to barrack 1B, if applicable.

General observations

Visitors must follow all directions and instructions given by staff.

Eating/drinking

Eating/drinking is only permitted in the museum café (and only of refreshments purchased there).

Smoking is not allowed in the building or the outdoor area.

For groups: Eating/drinking is allowed outside to the right of the front of the building near the benches. Eating/drinking is allowed in the reception hall (in consultation with the secretary's office) if available.

Use of mobile phones or video and photographic equipment

We ask you to turn off your mobile phones. Making phone calls is not allowed in the museum.

Filming and photography are permitted, provided intended for personal use. For professional purposes in consultation only.

Pets are not allowed

Pets are not allowed in CVNM. Service and guide dogs, on the other hand, are permitted on the site.

Site accessibility

CVNM is accessible for wheelchairs and pushchairs. Wheelchairs can also be borrowed at the desk.

Tours

Guided tours may only be given by officially recognised tour guides from Camp Vught NM.

Groups are requested to make a prior appointment.

Keep hand luggage with you.

Only small bags are allowed to be taken inside. Free lockers are available for larger bags.

The terms and conditions for visitors are available or will be made available for inspection on your request.
